

LOCAL TAXES

The real estate tax bills for the calendar year issued on Feb. 1 by the Township Treasurer are payable at a discount of 2% if paid between February 1 and March 31, at the flat rate if paid between April 1 and May 31, and with a 10% penalty if paid June 1 or thereafter. These taxes are levied on a millage basis on the assessed valuation of each property in the Township. The estimated tax total of assessed property in Radnor Township in 2007 is \$3,492,283,977.00. This tax base is used not only by the county but also by the local government and the School District for their income. The 2008 Township tax rate is 3.01 mills. The 2007 County tax rate is 4.45 mills.

The School District Tax is levied for the fiscal year of July 1 to June 30 by the Board of School Directors for the support of the Radnor Township School District. In 2007-2008 the School District Tax is 18.24 mills. In addition the School District receives a real estate transfer tax revenue of one half of 1% and state aid representing slightly more than 10% of the total budget. The Township also receives real estate transfer tax funds.

Other taxes now levied by Radnor Township are the mercantile tax (on certain kinds of businesses), the amusement tax (on certain kinds of admissions for entertainment), the occupational privilege tax (on people who work in Radnor Township), and business privilege tax (on service businesses). The township also levies an annual sewer rent. The rate was \$4.86 per thousand gallons of water used in 2006. There is no earned income tax in Radnor Township.
